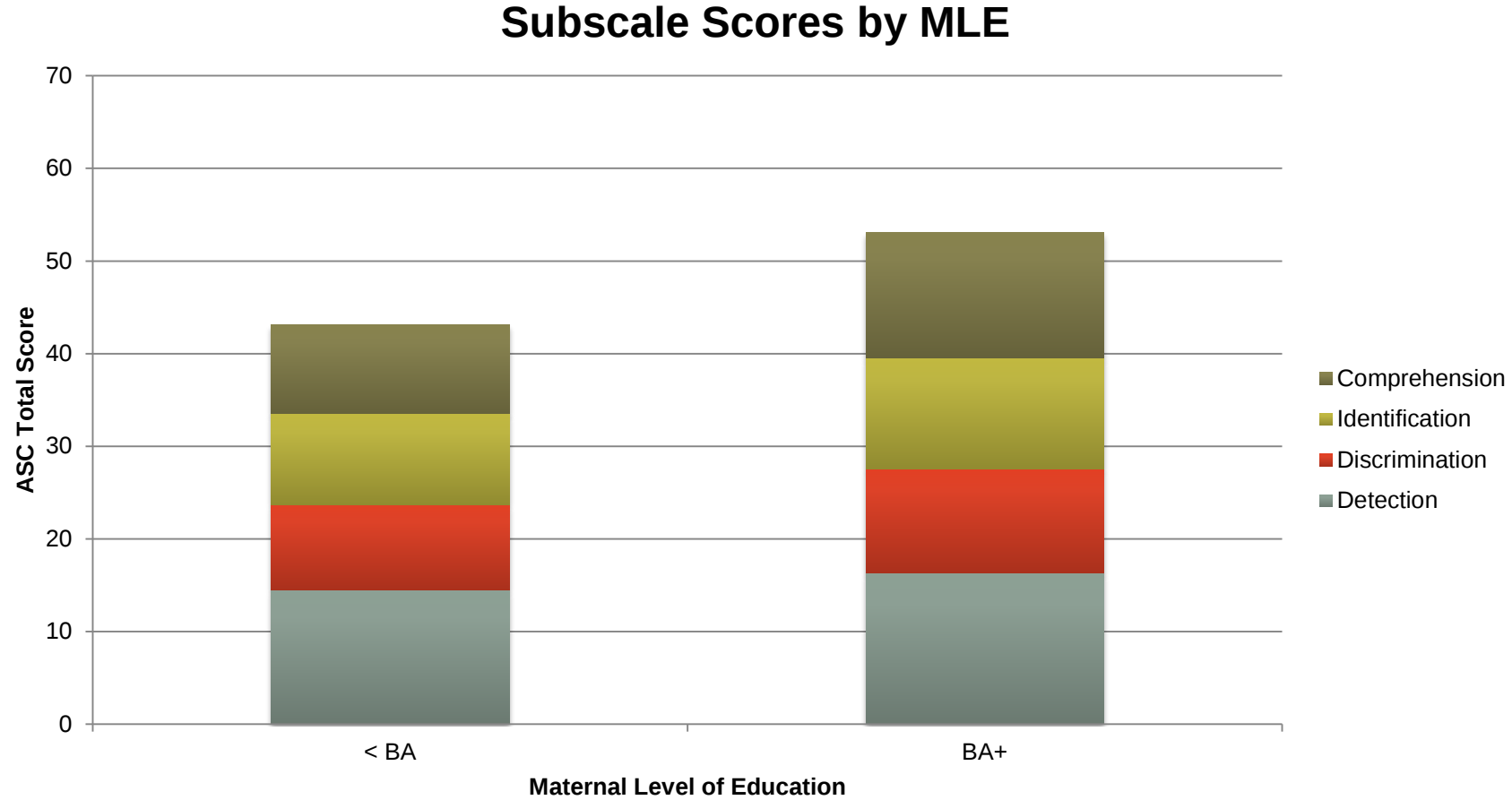

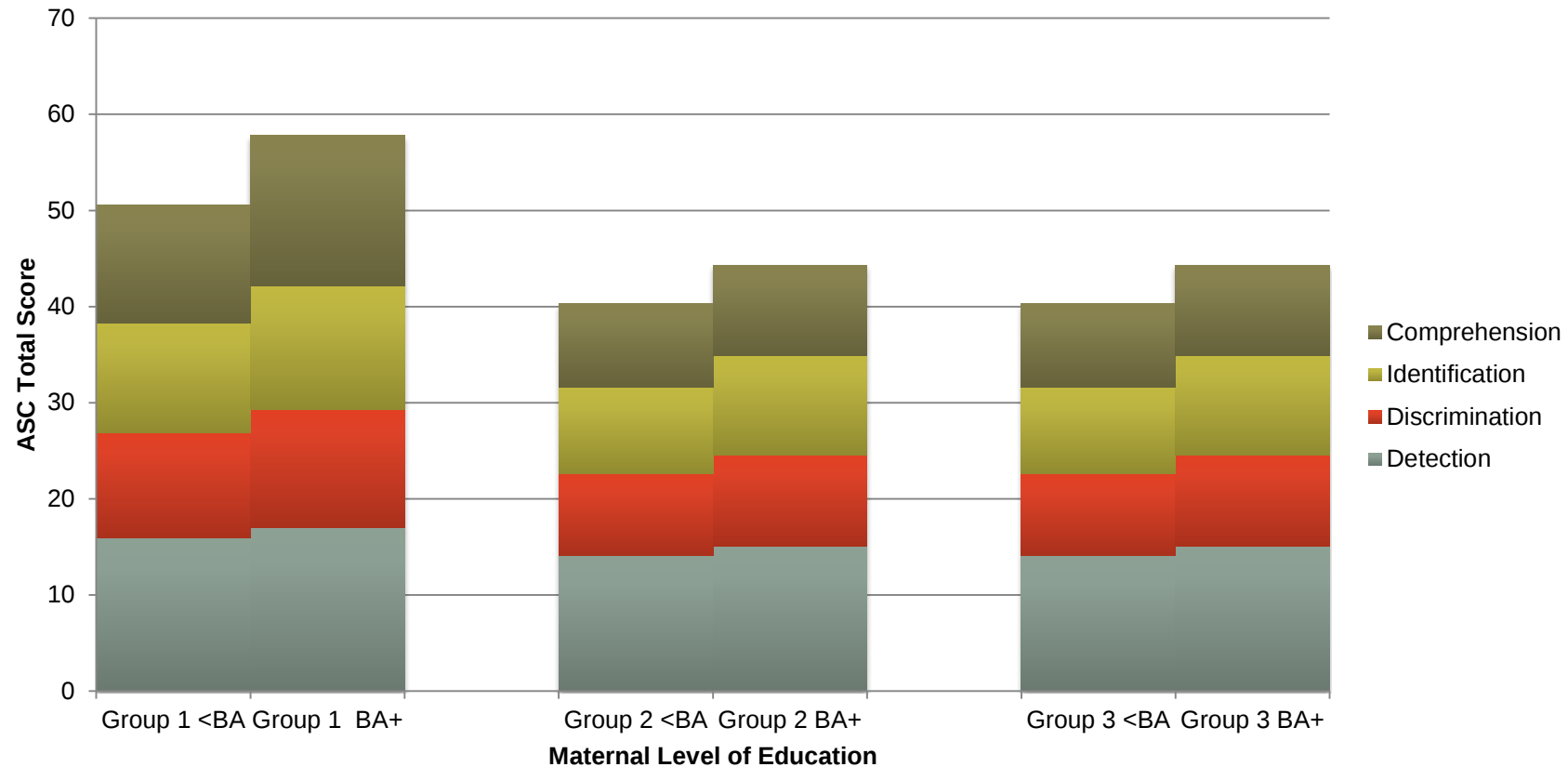

ASC scores by Mother's Level of Education

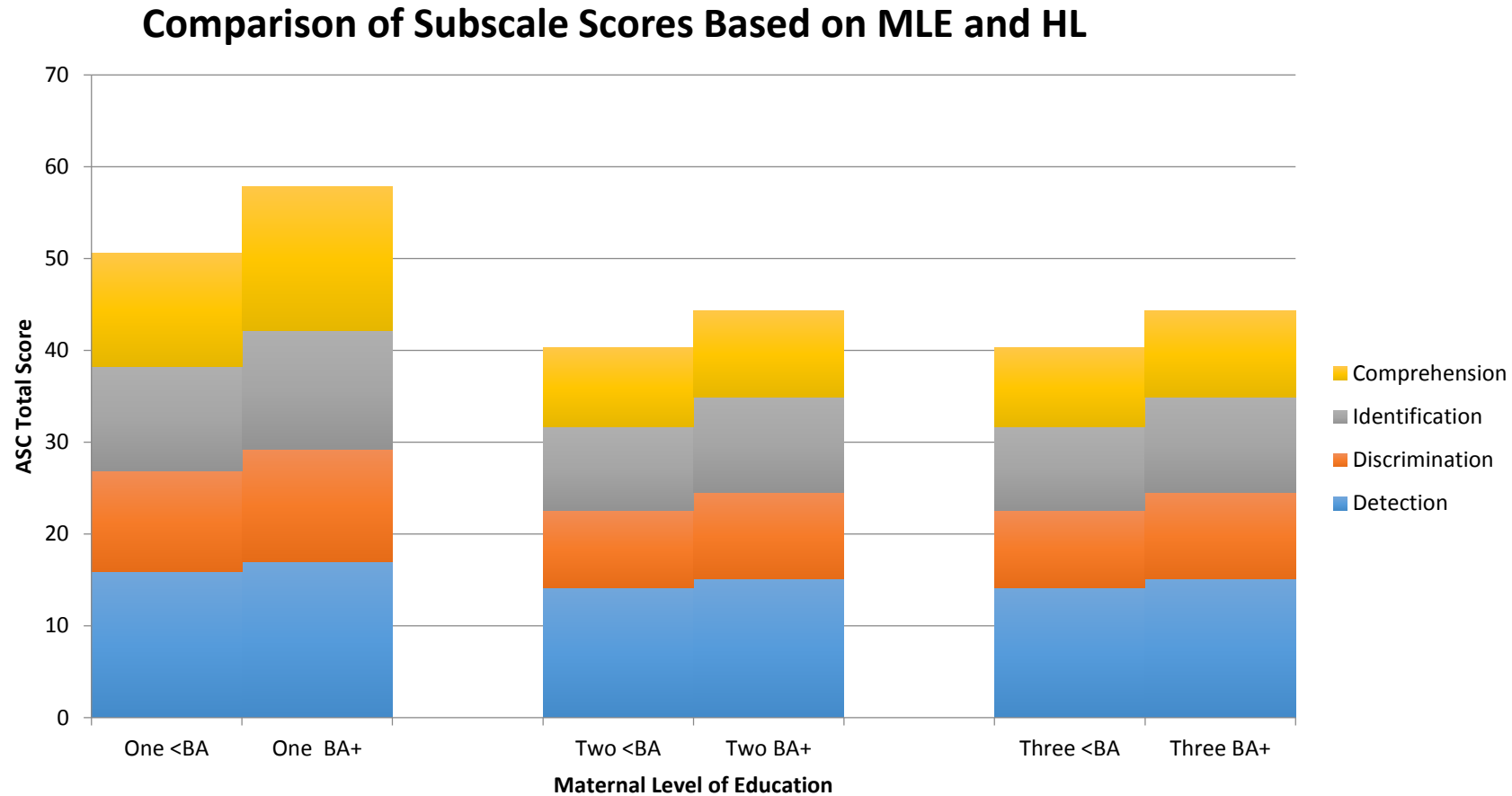


ASC scores by Mother's Level of Education and Hearing Loss

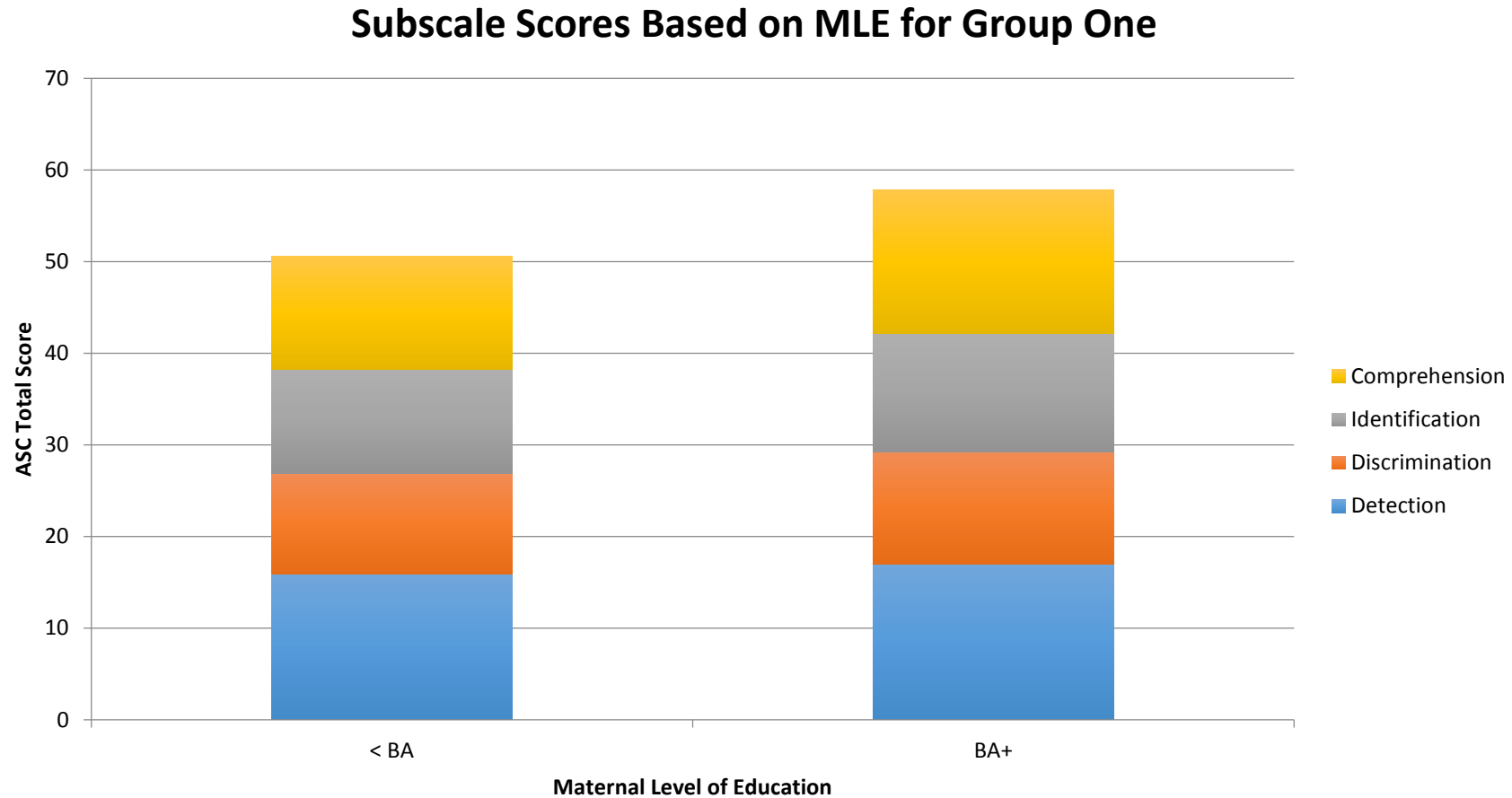
Comparison of Subscale Scores Based on MLE and HL



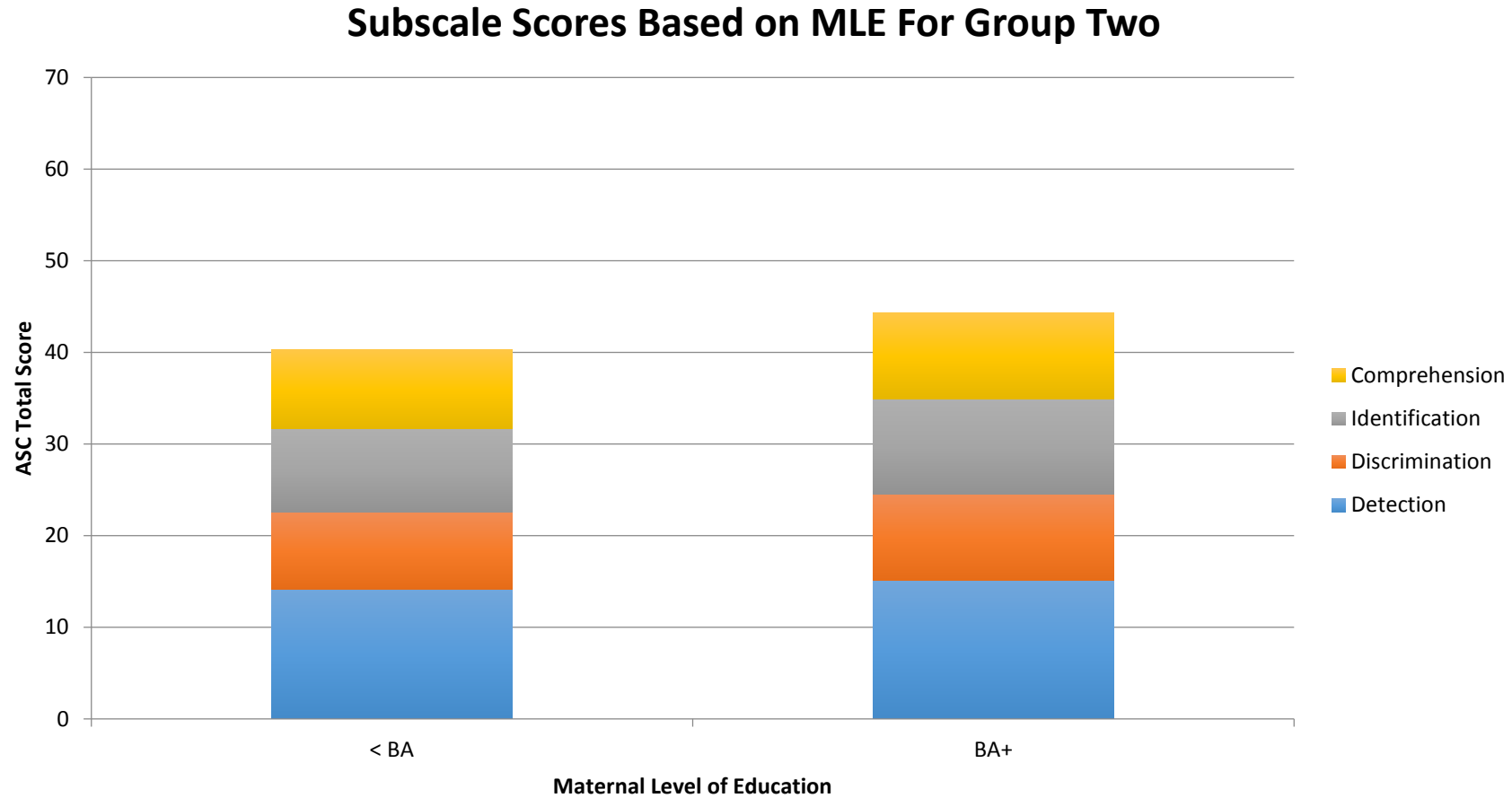
ASC subscale score by Mothers Level of Education and degree of HL
